

Statistics on potentially affected OCERS members and beneficiaries

1. There are 1,515 active law enforcement members of the retirement system who were first hired before June 28, 2002, and therefore have past credited service subject to Orange County Resolution 01-410.
2. Of that total, 1,434 currently are members of AOCDS, 4 currently are members of the Management Bargaining Unit and 77 currently are members of the Executive Bargaining Unit.
3. There are 339 AOCDS Bargaining Unit members who retired after June 28, 2002 with past service upgraded subject to Orange County Resolution 01-410. There are 23 benefit recipients receiving a benefit under a Domestic Relations Order arising from an AOCDS Bargaining Unit member's retirement benefit. There are 7 survivors receiving a benefit arising from a deceased AOCDS Bargaining Unit member's retirement.
4. There are 66 Management Bargaining Unit members who retired after June 28, 2002 with past service upgraded subject to Orange County Resolution 01-410. There are 9 benefit recipients receiving a benefit under a Domestic Relations Order arising from a Management Bargaining Unit member's retirement benefit. There are 2 survivors receiving a benefit arising from a deceased Management Bargaining Unit member's retirement benefit.
5. There are 11 Executive Bargaining Unit members who retired after June 28, 2002 with past service upgraded subject to Orange County Resolution 01-410. There are 2 benefit recipients receiving a benefit under a Domestic Relations Order arising from an Executive Bargaining Unit member's retirement benefit.
6. There are 72 deferred AOCDS members with past credited service subject to Orange County Resolution 01-410.
