#### **CIO COMMENTS**

Ms. Murphy announced the promotion of Stina Walander-Sarkin to Investment Officer. She noted that the organization is thankful for all the work that she does. Ms. Murphy provided an update on the current markets noting that the markets continue to slide. The portfolio updates provided at today's meeting will report numbers as of 3/31. Our portfolio is holding better than most peers.

Ms. Murphy reminded the Committee Orange County historically has had a conservative mindset and continues to be conservative with manager selections. The markets in general are down and currently resemble a bear market. Markets do not show confidence that the Federal Reserve has a handle on inflation. The OCERS portfolio is down approximately 5-7%. We will likely see volatile markets through the end of the year. Our portfolio Russia exposure is approximately 13 million. What has not been sold has been marked down. We have less than 1 million in equity markets and show negligible exposure moving forward.

OCERS has a rare year end calendar compared to peers. As of 3/31, the markets are down 5-10%. We will likely see down markets at 6/30. When we arrive at 12/31, we are hoping for some bounce back, but we will be sitting primarily on our 9/30 marks. This is sure to be an interesting year.
